


EDUCATION IN NORWAY





Primary School: 6 – 12 (7 years)







Lower Secondary School: 13 – 16 (3 years)







Upper Secondary School: 16 – 19 (3 years)







Primary and lower secondary education is mandatory

- The municipalities are responsible for the schools and the education
- No marks in primary school
- No optional subjects in primary school
- Foreign languages are optional subjects as from the age of 13
- English is not considered a foreign language (mandatory subject from year 1)







Upper secondary school is not mandatory, but everybody has a right to 3 years of education at this level

- General studies: 3 years (qualifies for higher education)
- Vocational education: 2 years in school and 2 years as apprentice
