- *In the beginning was the Word (Bible)*

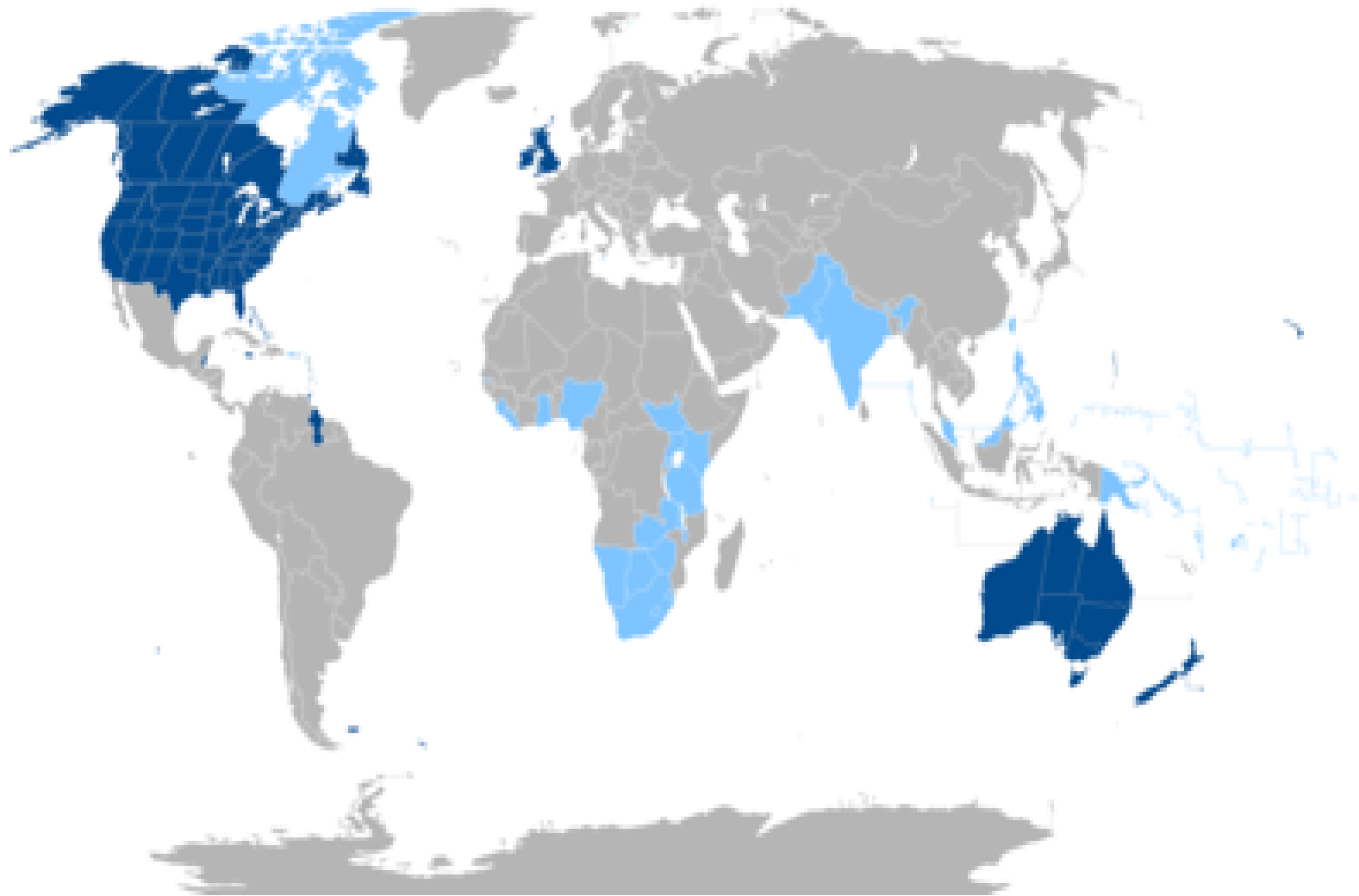
The definition of dialect and slang

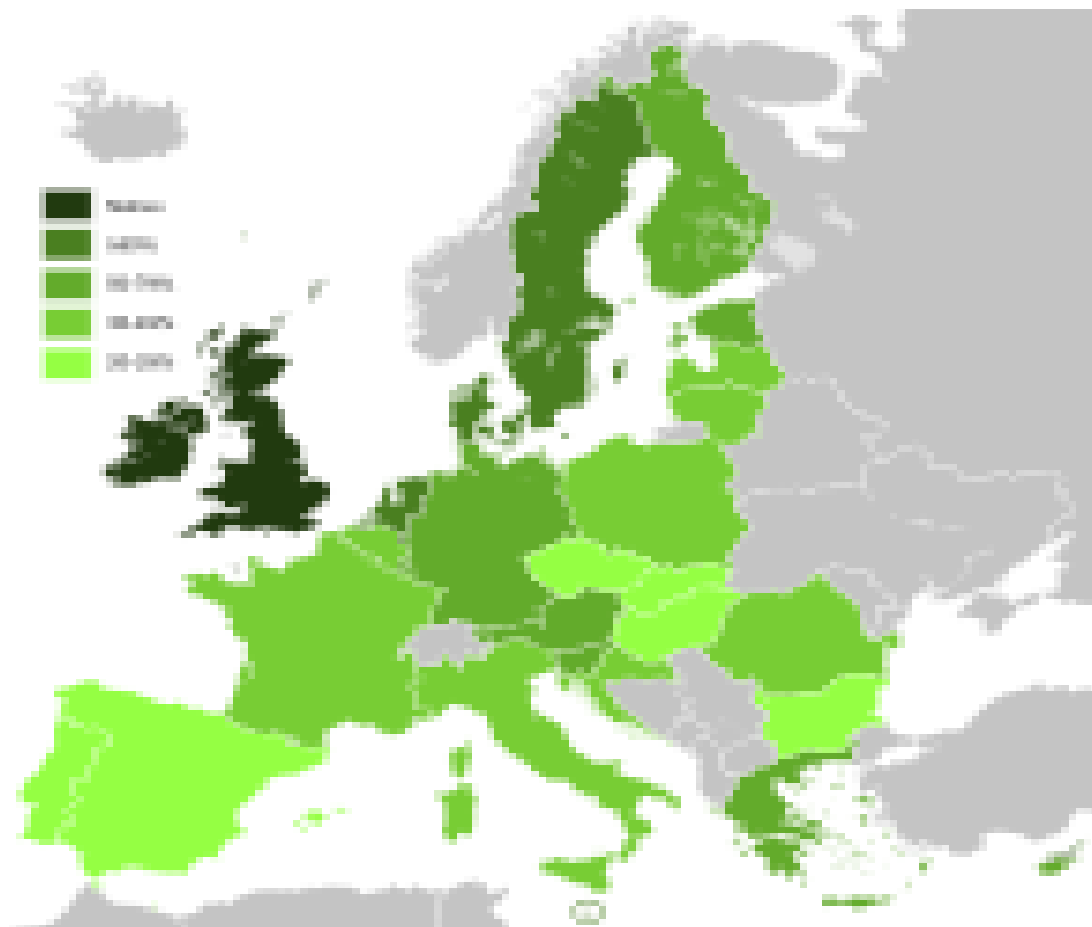

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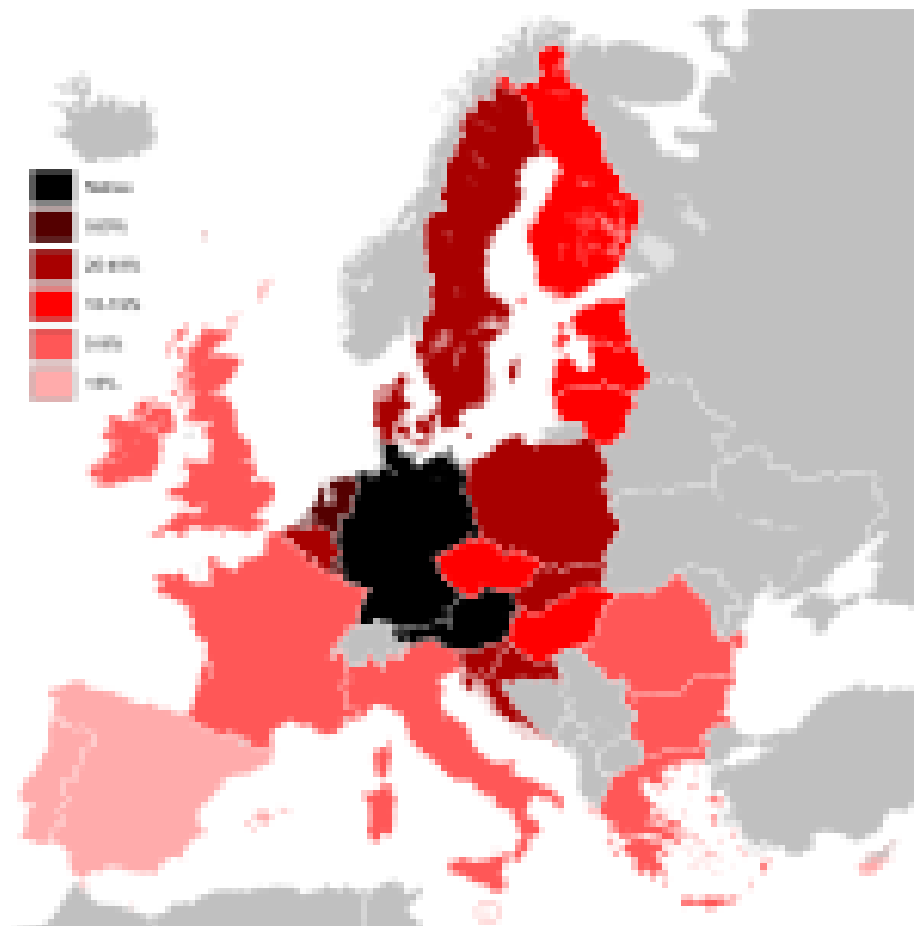
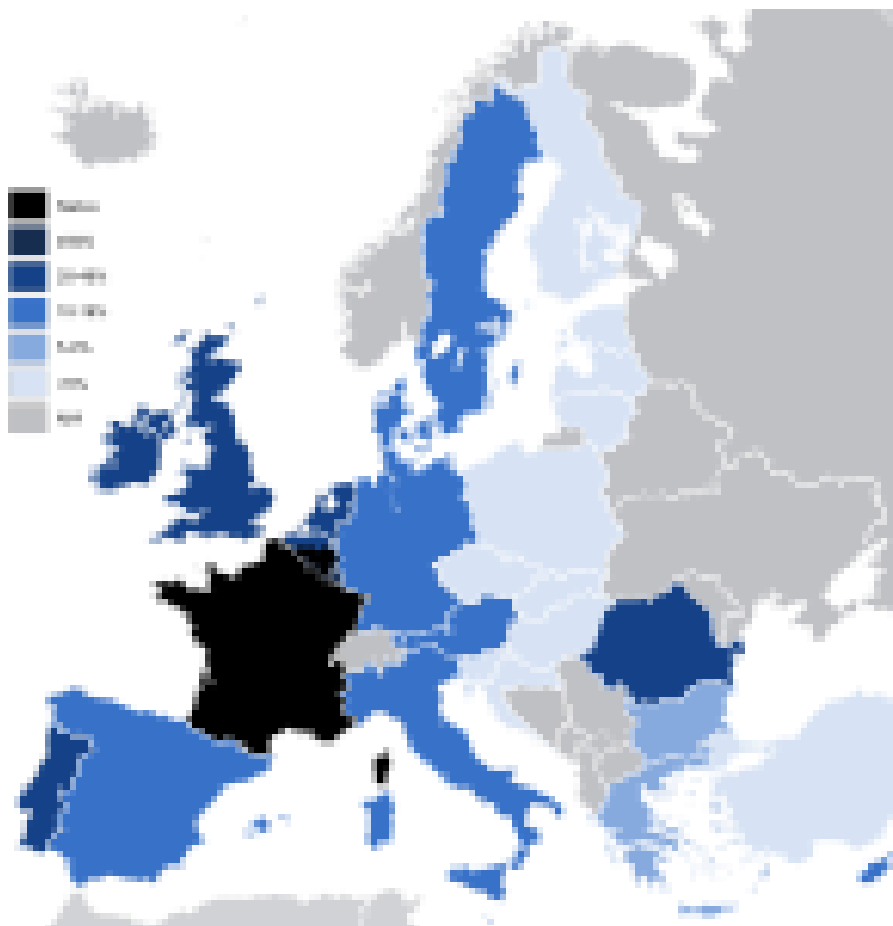

- The oldest known evidence of written Polish appears in the form of proper names seen in Latin language documents from the 12th century.

The first Polish sentence

- The Book of Henryków (Polish: Księga henrykowska, Latin: Liber foundationis claustris Sancte Marie Virginis in Heinrichau), contains the earliest known sentence written in the Polish language: Day, ut ia pobrusa, a ti poziwai (*pronounced originally as: Daj, uć ja pobrusza, a ti pocziwaj, modern Polish: Daj, niech ja pomiełę, a ty odpoczywaj, English: Come, let me grind, and you take a rest*), written around 1270.
