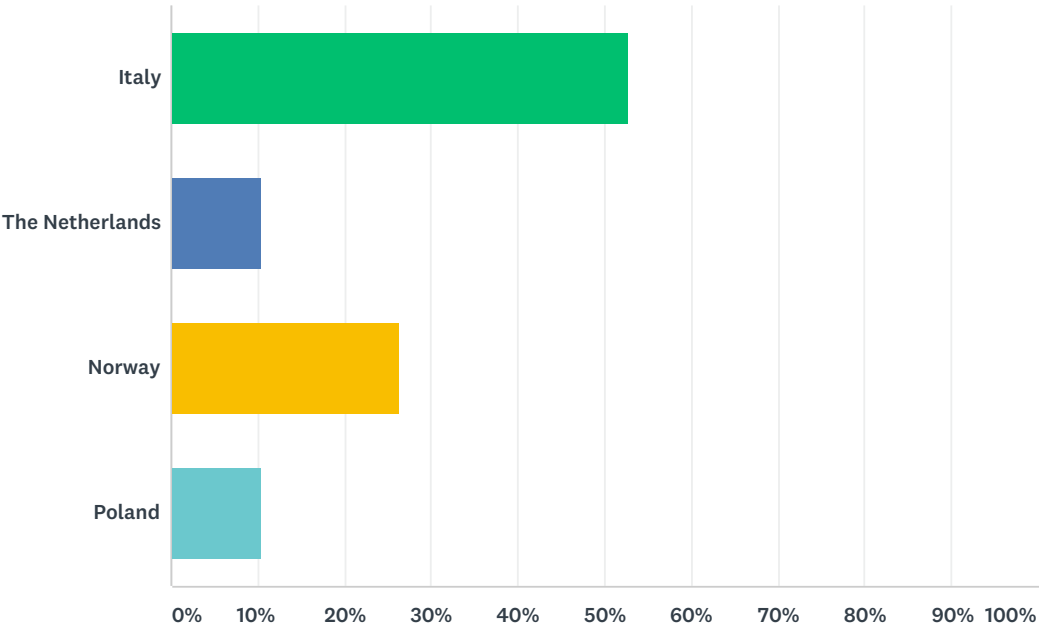


Q1 Were are you from?

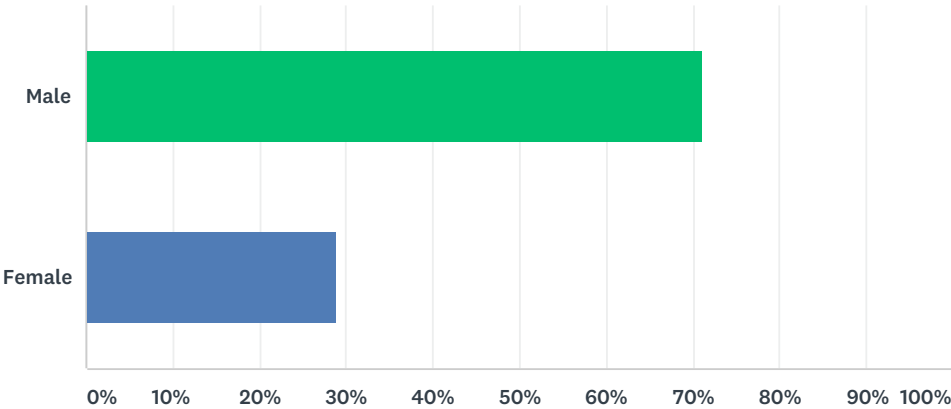

Q2 What gender are you?

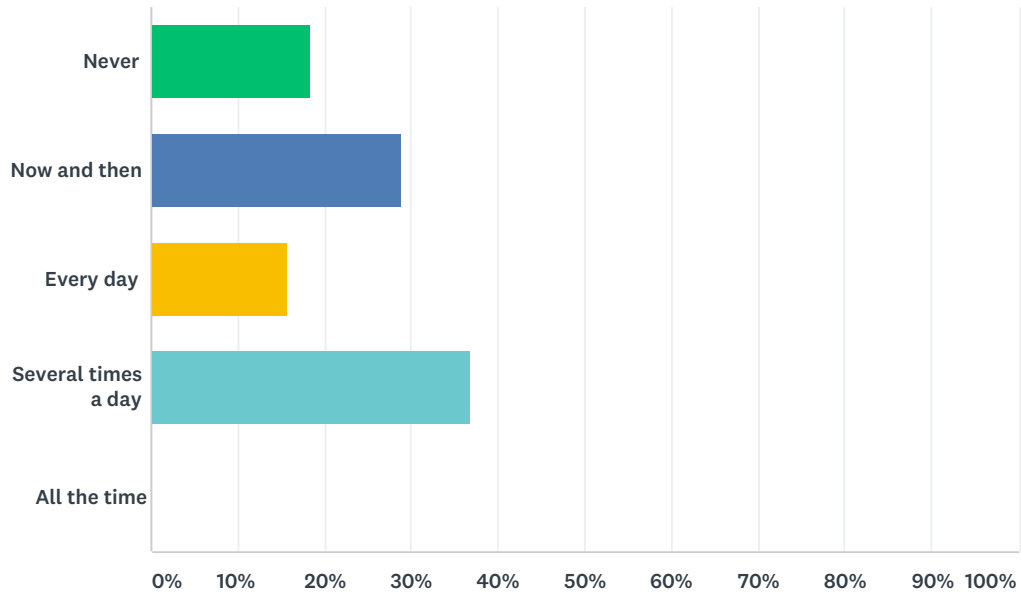

Q3 When speaking your mother tongue, to what extent do you use English words?

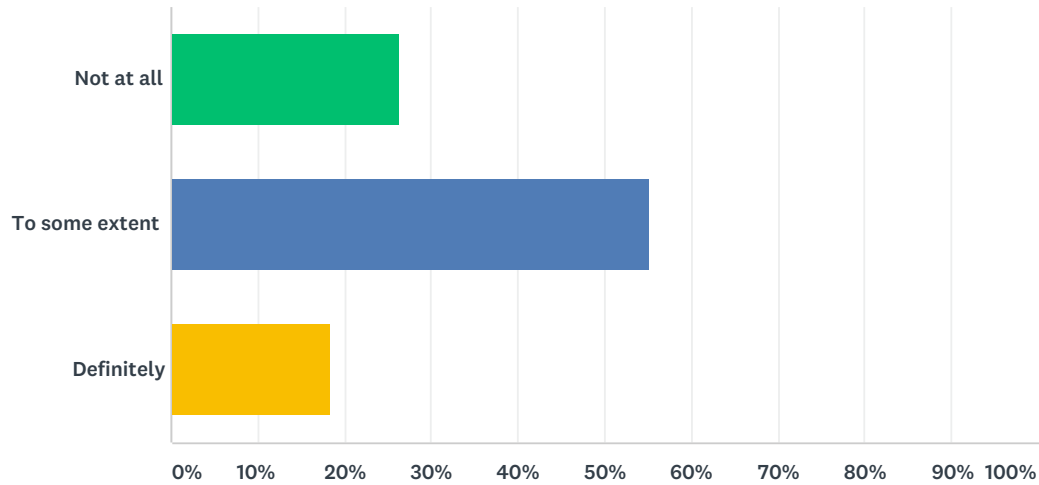

Q4 Does your use of English words in your mother tongue depend on whom you are together with?

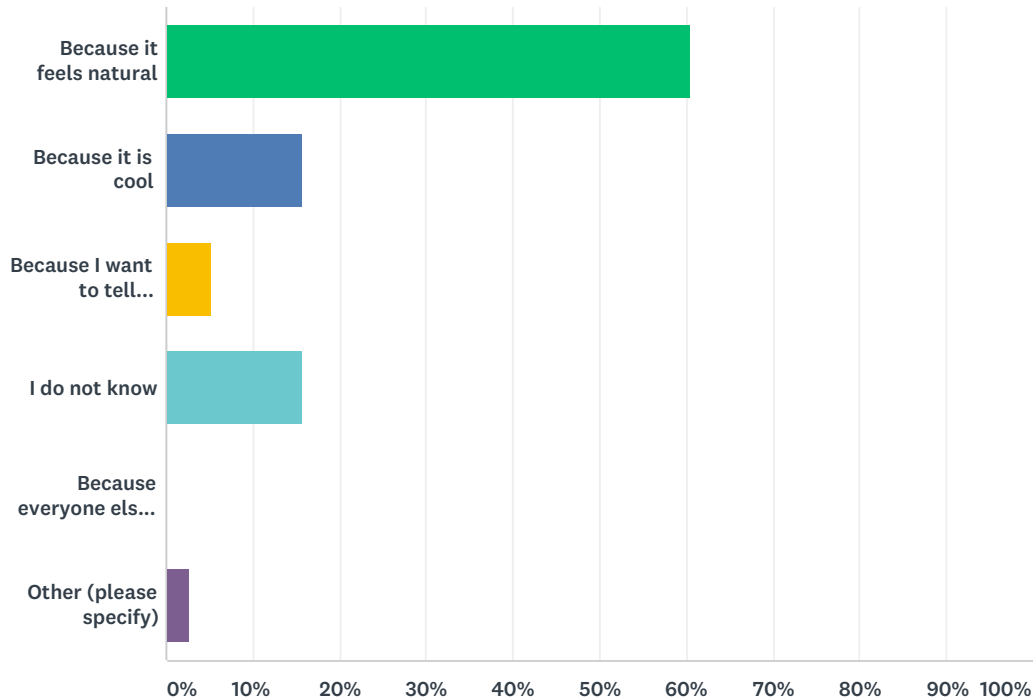

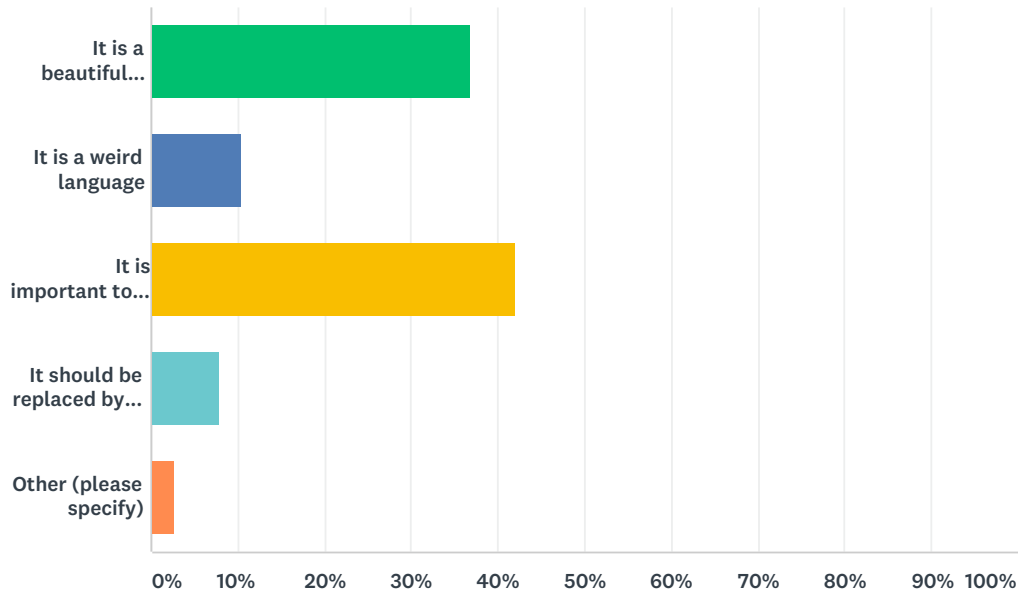

Q6 What is your opinion of your own language?

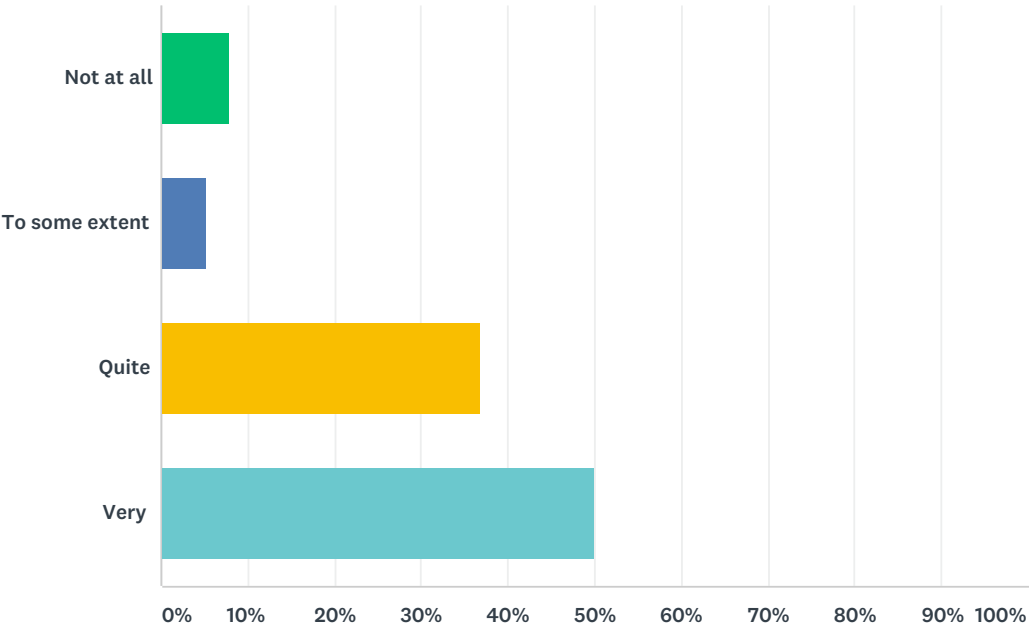
